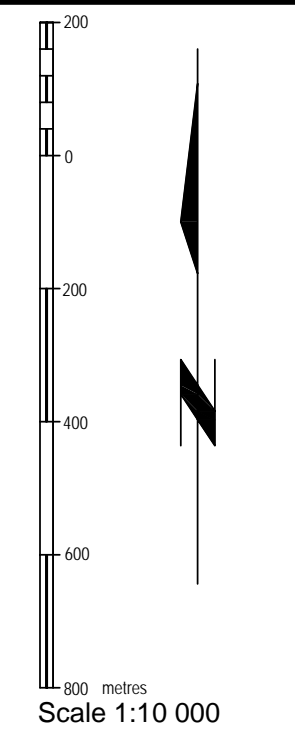


STONY PLAIN I. R. 135
